

TSCA declaration

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) is a United States federal law that includes a requirement that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) take expedited action on specific chemicals considered persistent, bio-accumulative, and toxic (PBT) to assess risks and reduce potential exposure.

Pursuant to TSCA §6(h), EPA identified five PBT substances, Decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE); phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)); 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2, 4, 6-TTBP); hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD); and pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) for expedited rulemaking. EPA issued final rules on each in January 2021.

The final rules identify risk management actions for each of the five PBT chemicals, including the prohibition of importing, manufacturing, processing, and distribution of products containing the chemical substances by certain dates.
